FIRST SESSION. 'Who is this Irenaeus?' An Introduction.

Who is this man whose name means 'peacemaker' and who is often called a 'bridge between East and West?' What do we know of his person, his life, and the context of his theological development? In our opening session, we shall explore the person of St Irenaeus, the background to his life and work, and introduce ourselves to the 'classic refrains' of Irenaeian appreciation: creation, the human person, the power of the incarnation, and the hope of the life in Christ.

SECOND SESSION. Children in Paradise: The Cosmos, Man, and the Will of God.

At the heart of Irenaeus' theological vision stands the human creature, born of dust and divine breath, the Divine Image around which the whole cosmos is situated. Partly in response to resonant voices in the world around him, but primarily through an 'Apostolic reading' of scripture, Irenaeus puts forward a dynamic vision of creation grounded in the centrality of the Father's love and power as Creator, calling all things into being through his Son and Spirit. In this session we shall explore Irenaeus' vision of the purpose and function of the cosmos, and in particular his presentation of its chief and master: the human person. Of what is the human person composed? What is her 'state' or nature at the beginning of history? In what sense does Irenaeus believe Adam and Eve to have been 'children' in Eden, and how does this view influence his vision of humanity's future perfection through the working of Christ?

THIRD SESSION. Reading History From the Empty Tomb.

Christian history begins at the empty tomb. Christians authentically look to their cosmic beginnings, as well as to their future ends, only from the perspective of the risen Lord whose incarnate life reveals the full reality and meaning of all history. In this session we shall explore Irenaeus' unique vision of history – a vision that sees the very love of God which proffers the incarnation, standing behind every act of God in the economy. Irenaeus offers unique readings of the expulsion of Adam and Eve from Paradise, the sin of Cain, the tower at Babe4' and throughout, he weaves together themes of sin, salvation, falls and growth, good and evil matter and spirit, into a picture of history fulfilled in the incarnation, yet awaiting its ultimate manifestation in the future.

FOURTH SESSION. Approaching Adulthood: Christian Present and Christian Future.

If 'the beginnings' when read from the perspective of the empty tomb, reveal something of our human character and nature, 'the ends' tell us something of our coming development and growth. Irenaeus is deeply 'eschatological', rooted in the future life as much as the past, and his conception of the consummation of history and human growth lies at the heart of his understanding of salvation. In this final session we shall examine how Irenaeus' reading of Christ's chief work - the 'recapitulation' of human life - provides the means of our progress into perfection. The 'New Adam' transforms the old, even as the 'New Eve' (the Mother of God) transforms humanity's first mother. The child, trained in obedience and illumined by the Spirit, ascends henceforth into life.
